

Bobcat Trail CDD Landscaping Hurricane Ian Damage Update

On September 28, 2022 Hurricane Ian wreaked havoc on the Bobcat Trail community. Ian blew down or damaged over 160 trees in the CDD property of Bobcat community. Hundreds of shrubs, plantings, and other decorative items were also damaged or destroyed. The cleanup was a massive undertaking by the community and the City, but was pretty much completed by the end of February.

The rebuilding has begun! The Landscape Committee along with help from LMP has created a plan to replace the damaged trees, shrubs, and plants. In the next few weeks, you will see new plantings in the Bobcat boulevard, the monuments, and entrances. The following is a small sample rendering of what you will see being planted in our community! 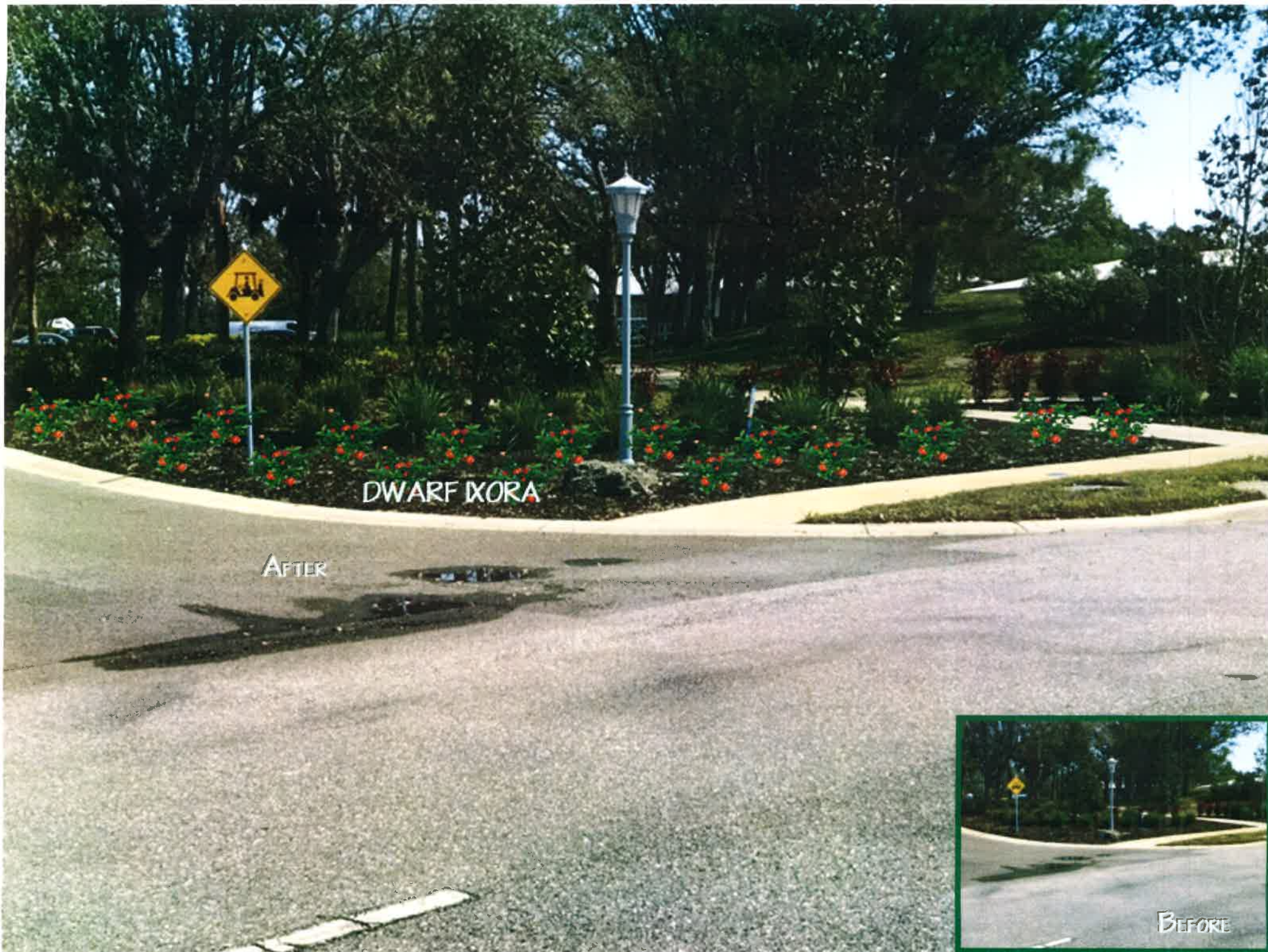
